Technical Integration

SAP Shipping Module

LP EasyCEP uses **SAP Express Shipment Interface (XSI)** – the standard CEP interface in SAP for shipping parcels via parcel service providers.

SAP EWM

Integration is carried out via the **ESI interface** and is directly embedded into the packing and workstation processes.

Installation & Go-Live

LP EasyCEP is installed via SAP Transport. Thanks to pre-configured standard processes, it can be deployed quickly, including customer-specific extensions.
